

ALP160 CA Mode switching

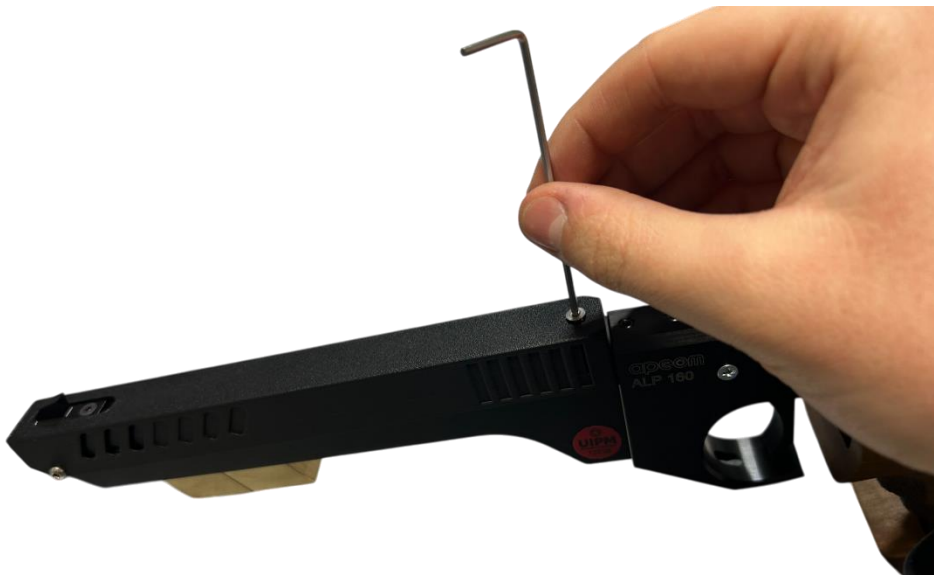
If you want to use the aiming curve mode or mode for “blind shooting” on your target, you will need a special laser gun to do so. This special laser emitter can be put into our laser pistols or laser rifles.

You can switch between two modes:

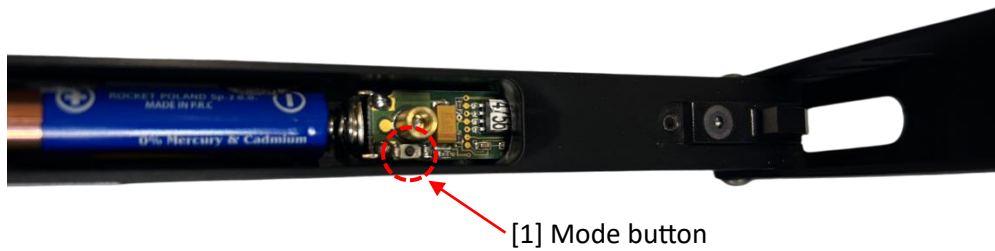
- 1) **Standard one-shot mode** – Only one shot per trigger pull
- 2) **Aiming curve mode** – First shot starts the laser which stays on. Then you start aiming on the target. Once you want, you shoot again and the laser will quickly flash and then stay on for a while. This makes the trajectory of your gun before and after shot visible.

How to change your shooting mode

- 1) Loosen the screw that is on top of the barrel cover with the allen key from the toolbox. After the screw is loose enough, you should be able to lift the barrel cover.



- 2) Locate the small button switch [1]



- 3) Use the allen key you used for loosening the barrel cover. Place it on the top of the button and load the gun. Now gently press it (Do not push too hard or you will break the button. You will hear and feel a little click.) Now hold the button and pull the trigger. The gun should emit laser and change its mode



- 4) That is all. You have now changed the mode. Close the barrel cover following the steps in reverse and any time you need to change the mode again, repeat the process.
